# Around Every Corner

**RULES:** IDPA Rule Book 2005  
**CONCEALMENT GARMENT:** Required

**COURSE DESIGNER:** Jon Santini

**STARTING POSITION:** Standing at P1, hands relaxed at sides, gun holstered and loaded to division capacity.

**SCENARIO:** You are walking down the street in a bad section of town when you notice two guys with guns in their hands. When they see you, they start to point their guns at you. You are unaware that their partners are just around each corner. Defend yourself and get out of there, but be careful not to walk into additional threats.

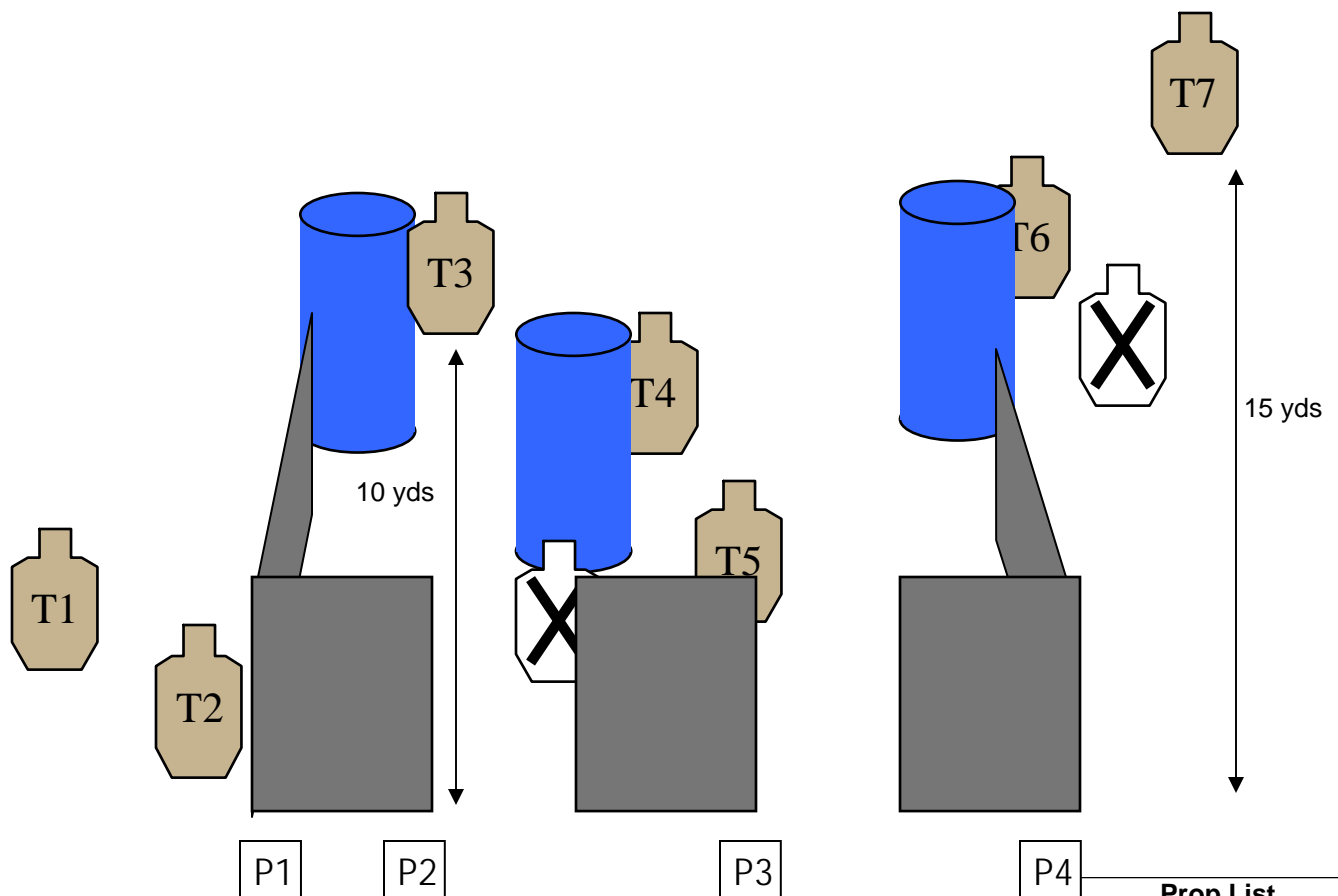
**STAGE PROCEDURE:** At the start signal, draw and engage T1-T2 with 2 shots each. Advance to P2 and engage T3 with 2 shots. Advance to P3 and engage T4-T5 with 2 shots each. Advance to P4 and engage T6-T7 with 2 shots each.

Notes:

- Re-load as necessary using any IDPA re-load. Do not leave cover with an empty gun.
- Barrels and non-threats are positioned to not be able to engage targets designated for the next shooting position.

**SCORING:** Vickers Count  
**ROUND COUNT:** 14 Minimum  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 shots on paper

**RELOADS:** Any IDPA reloads  
**START-STOP:** Audible and last shot
